CANCER AND CELL PHONE EMISSIONS

Research on the links between cell phones, cell phone base stations and cancer has yielded mixed results. Some studies have found no increased risk, others have found elevated risk. With this excuse, industry continues to spread this technology and governments continue to claim that their regulations make cell phones and their base stations safe. But in reality, the inconsistency in research results merely means that more research is needed to determine the mechanisms at work.

Such factors as the frequency and cumulative amount of exposure, and the angle of the radiation, are already thought to influence the cancer risk, and thus the results of the scientific studies. In addition, studies funded by industry have shown a high likelihood of finding no links. Industry scientists who find links can lose their research funding or be fired, and that has happened to several expert scientists.

What is offered here is only a very brief glimpse at a few items in the large body of scientific evidence that is available. With the credible scientists and research journals listed here, and the seriousness of the findings, Valhalla Society staff have thrown out their cell phones and cordless phones.

“People whose houses are in a field gradient strength of 1.5 to 3 volts/metre will get their immune system reduced by nearly 90% after 6 months and many will have nightmare lives with headaches, rashes, forgetfulness and perhaps electromagnetic hypersensitivity (EHS) and after 5 years the cancer rate increases by about 2 per cent per year of exposure. If you add up the total registered as EHS in Sweden and California it is nearly 1 million. English hospitals are fairly devoid of treatments for this!...

We have heard many data-less ungrounded generalisations from the authorities to support the combined vested interests of mobile telephone industry and Government. The Mobile telephone Industry is still grooming political parties that fiction is reality and reality is fiction (scare stories)! This is the only defence they have, they have no technical defence.

Taiwan has removed 9000 masts last year and is removing another 9000 masts again this year out of the 27,000 complained about. Sweden is sanitising houses and providing houses well away from masts if this is necessary. When is our Government going to start?”

CANCER CLUSTERS AROUND CELL PHONE BASE STATIONS

The British news service TimesOnline reported that a study by Dr. John Walker, conducted in Britain, found “seven clusters of cancer and other serious illnesses have been discovered around mobile phone masts, raising concerns over the technology’s potential impact on health.

“Studies of the sites show high incidences of cancer, brain haemorrhages and high blood pressure within a radius of 400 yards of mobile phone masts.

“One of the studies, in Warwickshire, showed a cluster of 31 cancers around a single street. A quarter of the 30 staff at a special school within sight of the 90ft high mast have developed tumours since 2000, while another quarter have suffered significant health problems ...

In Melbourne, Australia, 7 staff members in the Business School of the TCIM University developed brain tumours within 7 years. Five of the tumours were discovered within one month, and two were malignant. These people worked on the top two floors of a building that had a cell phone tower on the roof. After an investigation university spokespeople said it was a coincidental occurrence.

A study by two medical doctors in Netanya, Israel, documented 8 cancer cases in one year within 350 metres of a cell phone transmitter — 4.15 times more than in the general population. The doctors pointed out that the level of radiation was far below the guidelines in effect in Israel. They noted that one year after the close of the study, 8 new cases of cancer were diagnosed in the study area. They stated: “We are aware of at least two areas in which a drastic increase in the incidence of cancer cases occurred near a cell-phone antenna.”

A 10-year study in the German city of Naila found that the risk of cancer was three times greater for residents living within 400 metres of a cell phone transmitter, than for those living further away (Eger, et al., 2004).

- New research by epidemiologists from 5 European countries, to be published in the International Journal of Cancer, has concluded that people who had used cell phones for more than 10 years were 39% more likely than average to get a glioma (brain cancer) on the side of their head where held their cell phones. “Long term cell phone use raises brain tumour risk: new study, 31 March 2006, Reuters, Stockholm

Researchers at the Swedish National Institute for Working Life compared data from 2,200 cancer patients and an equal number of healthy patients. Those who heavily used wireless phones had a 240 percent increased risk of a cancerous tumour on the side of the head where they used their phone.
